

## Policies and Procedures

Things to Do and Not to do to ensure a successful week:

- **Do** wear closed-toe shoes.
- **Do** wear / bring insect repellent
- **Do** bring a bag lunch or snacks and plenty of water. (Refrigerator and microwave are available)
- Be open to new ideas and opportunities
- This is a judgment-free zone where you can freely express your thoughts and feelings.
- Camp will begin promptly at 9am. Please drop off your camper at the metal building at the end of the driveway each morning between 8:45 - 8:55
- Indoor restroom is available.
- No cell phone or device use during camp hours (9am - 1pm)  
\*Campers may check phone/text messages during break.
- Camp is scheduled to end at 1pm. Please pick your camper up between 1:00 - 1:15pm at the metal building at the end of the driveway.
- **Do not** feed the animals without permission
- **Do not** enter a pasture without permission
- **Do not** wear excessive jewelry, tassels or fringe on clothing (so the horses don't have anything to grab on to)

*If any camper feels the need to be negative towards another camper, please request to speak with a leader.*

*Offenders of this rule will be asked to sit out for the remainder of the session.*

*If negativity, foul language, or judgment persist, camper will not be allowed to future sessions*

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
